

It's been quite a journey.

Five years ago, we embarked on the **Destined Under the Dome Campaign** to address our parish's capital needs. The projects included, among other things, replacing the front steps and the heating and air conditioning system of our church building, as well as repointing the bell tower and restoring the gold dome. Five years and one pandemic later, we've accomplished all those tasks.

Still, more work remains: we need to replace the restrooms in the church, make some improvements to its interior, as well as restore the Nativity stained-glass window. The roof of our Parish Center (the old school building) and the windows of our rectory need to be replaced, and our parking lot needs to be repaved and fenced in.

To that end, we are embarking on a three-year extension of our original campaign, entitling it **Destined Under the Dome 2.0**. We hope to address most of our needs by setting a goal of \$450,000. Unlike the initial campaign (40% of those proceeds went to the Archdiocese of Baltimore), 100% of the proceeds from **Destined Under the Dome 2.0** will stay in the parish and be applied toward our needs.

Nearly every active household of our church family participated in the first campaign, and I am grateful for everyone's support. Now, I ask that you continue to work with me in addressing the capital needs that still await us. I am confident that, together, we can continue our mission — **"to know and love God and proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ to ourselves and others through our example of a community expressing love and service"** — all in our Home Under the Dome.

ALREADY ACCOMPLISHED

Destined Under the Dome 1.0

From July 2017 to June 2022, St. Bernardine's raised approximately \$670,000, with nearly \$370,000 going to the parish and the remainder to the Archdiocese and campaign expenses. With those proceeds, two grants from the Knott Foundation (\$95,000), and parish savings, we accomplished the following:

Church Front Steps (\$90,000)

We replaced the deteriorated front steps of the church with a courtyard-style front porch and ramp in the spring of 2018.

Holy Family Stained-Glass Window (\$11,000)

With the window of the Holy Family buckling unexpectedly, we quickly restored and preserved it in the summer of 2018.

Church HVAC (\$284,000)

When the church's heating and air conditioning system began to fail sooner than expected, we replaced it in the fall of 2020.

Church Roof (\$27,000)

We repaired the church roof at various times over the course of the campaign due to storms and other issues.

Church Bell Tower and Dome (\$218,000)

Workers erected scaffolding, began cleaning and repointing the tower, and restored our famed gold dome in the spring of 2022.

Destined Under the Dome 2.0 seeks to accomplish projects that have been on our "to-do list" for quite some time.

Install New Church Restrooms (\$125,000)

Our hope is to install all new restrooms in the church where the choir room and current restrooms are located. (The choir room will be moved to the Parish Center.)

Replace Parish Center Roof (\$175,000) and Rectory Windows (\$75,000)

Next, we'll focus our attention on basic structural needs by replacing the roof of the Parish Center and the windows in the rectory.

Install New Carpeting, Replace Sanctuary Platform and Other Church Improvements (\$50,000) and Restore Nativity Stained-Glass Window (\$40,000) Then, we'll return to the church and upgrade its interior, as well as restore the nativity stained-glass window.

Repave and Install Parking Lot Fence (\$20,000)

Finally, we hope to repave and install a fence around the parking lot.

Our "wish list" continues with future projects that we do not expect to address with this campaign unless the opportunity or need to do so arises.

Future Projects:

Parish Center: Remodel and paint classrooms. **Harcum Hall:** New handicapped ramp and restroom, refresh kitchen.

School Annex (next to rectory): Replace roof and renovate classrooms.

The priority of the above Case Elements and Future Projects may change as circumstances require. ALL FUNDS RAISED IN THIS CAMPAIGN WILL BE APPLIED TO THESE PROJECTS AND CAMPAIGN EXPENSES.
